

Course Title **Individualizing Teaching Lessons**

Modifying and Adapting Curricular Content to Meet the Needs of Primary School Pupils with ASD

Course Overview

This half or full-day course is designed to inform the participant about the ways in which the delivery of the curriculum to a whole class can be adapted and modified to suit learners with ASD in inclusive classroom sessions. The course will focus on "quick and easy" strategies for better reaching the learner with ASD during typical lessons, and will provide practical advice in relation to the design and use of autism-specific strategies. Additionally, participants will have facilitated practice in adapting and modifying targets, and will generate strategies for implementation in their own inclusive classrooms.

Course Objectives

- Participants will develop an understanding of the common difficulties pupils with ASD experience when accessing the curriculum in a mainstream environment.
- Participants will develop an awareness of a number of whole-class strategies and individual strategies that can be used to help pupils with ASD access information in the large and small group settings.
- Participants will develop the ability to adapt and modify large and small group learning activities to help individual pupils with ASD access the lesson in a meaningful and engaging way.
